Notes for the Wine List:

Flavors –Rich, dark fruit, pepper, and coffee

Aromas –Blackberry and plum, earthy spice

Finish – Peppery tannins and bright acidity

Food Pairing:

Backyard get-together wine. Great alone, but serve with a variety of cheeses, spring garden salad topped with bleu cheese and caramelized pecans, or a great steak on the BBQ.

Tasting Notes:

Not your average Merlot, this wine presents initial aromas of black fruit and cassis with a touch of earthy spiciness. The flavors of blackberry, plums and blueberry are balanced by notes of coffee and white pepper. Harmonious acidity and tannin give this Merlot structure and interest.
