About us:

Cliff Creek Cellars and Sams Valley Vineyard are located in the Upper Rogue Valley of Southern Oregon. We planted our first vines in 2000 and now have approximately 70 acres planted. The vineyard lies with southwestern exposure at 1400 ft. elevation. One of the unique attributes of our soil is a strain of Crater Lake volcanic ash running through the entire vineyard. Soil is the heart of the vineyard and we think this adds to the unique quality of our wines.

This vintage exhibits an aromatic nose of cedar smoke, bacon and clove. An earthy, herbaceous and peppery mid palate make this wine a savory accompaniment to hearty lamb dish. The finish lingers with soft, elegant tannins.
