Our ever so popular red table wine. This vintage is dark and sultry with a base of dried cherry, fresh pipe tobacco and red cedar. Sanguine in color and medium bodied, this blend starts earthy and finishes with layers of inky fruit, red pepper with hints of spice and cloves.

About us:

Red Red Wine is a second label produced by *Cliff Creek Cellars* in the Upper Rogue Valley of Southern Oregon. We broke ground on our vineyard in 1999 and now have approximately 70 acres planted in vines. This was our first year using fruit purchased from Fly High Vineyard, an all organic vineyard in the Applegate Valley.

Part of what makes **Red Red Wine** particularly special to the Cliff Creek Family, is that 5% of proceeds from this wine are contributed to cancer research at OHSU. **Red Red Wine** truly is a quality table red meant to enjoy any night of the week.
