Tasting Notes

The nose leads you in with an aroma that reminds me of a bright cherry pie made from Door County, Wisconsin fruit. Then a waft of vanilla crumb on top, it is so inviting. A smooth texture hits your mouth and is rounded out by fresh notes of mint and rosemary. The mid palate shows off blueberry and milk chocolate. The finish is full of plum and black cherry, with a hint of allspice.

Vineyard Notes

This was taken from an Applegate Vineyard called Silver Star Vineyard. It is a cooler location than our vineyard and the vines are 5-7 years old. It is a certified organic vineyard. The fruit ripened nicely and came off with a good balance.
